

# Heart Square block

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## Material needed to make one 12" (12 1/2" unfinished) Heart Square:

**Fabric 'A' (heart):** Three 4" squares; 1 rectangle 6 1/2" x 12 1/2".

**Fabric 'B' (background):** Three 4" squares (draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square).  
Four 3 1/2" squares (draw a diagonal line on the back of 2 squares).

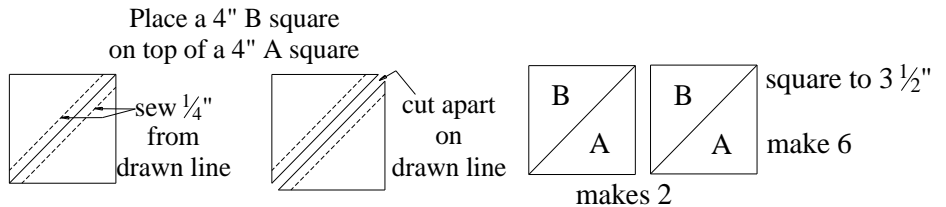
## Making the Heart blocks:

- 1) Place a Fabric 'B' 4" square on top of a Fabric 'A' 4" square. Sew 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line.

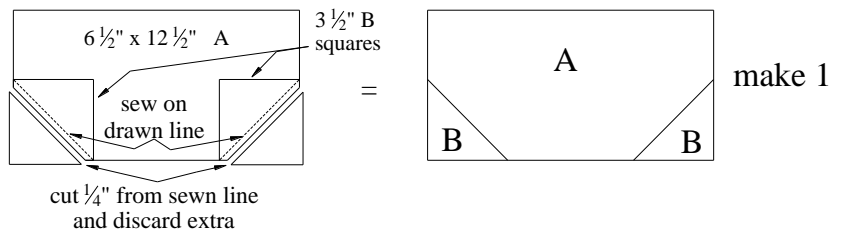
Cut along the drawn line.

Open and press towards Fabric 'A'. Trim this Half Square Triangle (HST) to 3 1/2" square.

Repeat with the remaining Fabric 'B' and Fabric 'A' 4" square. Make 6 trimmed 3 1/2" A/B HSTs.



- 2) Place a 3 1/2" Fabric 'B' square with a drawn line on both lower corners of the 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric 'A' rectangle. Sew on the drawn line. Cut away the extra, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Make 1



- 3) Using the HSTs made in step 1, the rectangle made in step 2 and the 3 1/2" Fabric 'B' squares, assemble the Heart blocks as shown.  
-Press bulky seams open.
