- A workshop designed to explore the use of simple embroidery stitches, wool appliqué, and beads, charms or buttons on pieced and/or appliquéd quilt blocks.
- Additional techniques such as Kantha stitching, Sashiko and Victorian Crazy Quilting will be discussed and demonstrated as time allows.
- A kit including quilt blocks, fabrics, misc. threads, needles, etc. will be provided for practice. Participants need only bring a pair of small, sharp, pointed scissors, and a thimble and embroidery hoop if they like to use them.
