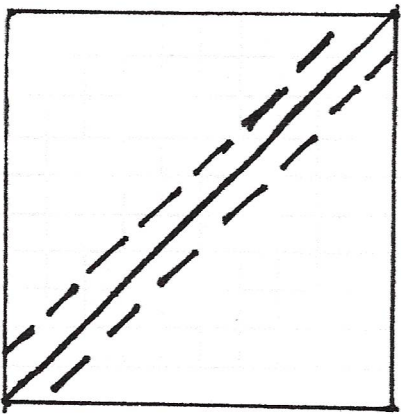

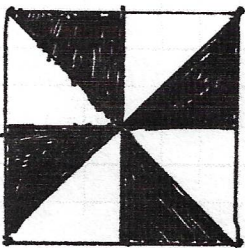

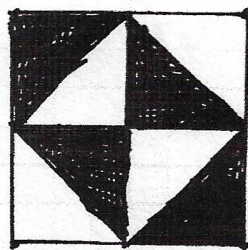
— cut line

cut 2 - 6 1/2" □ colour 1
 cut 2 - 6 1/2" □ colour 2
 sew, cut, trim to 6"
 colours 1 + 2 together.

sew 4 (1/2 □ □) together to form pinwheels
 and hourglass Blocks



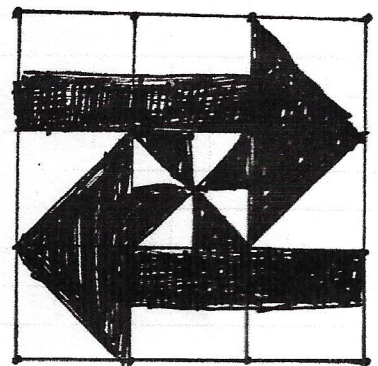
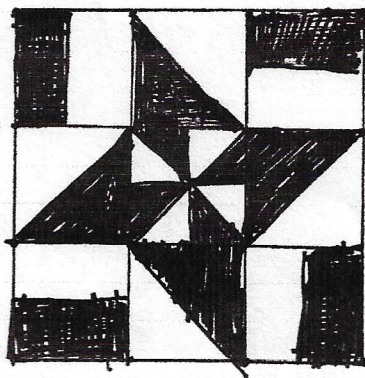
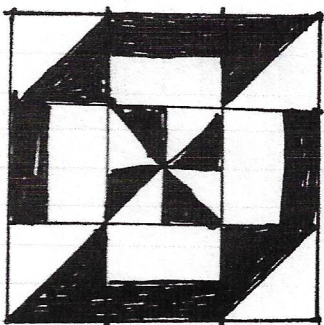
pinwheel
 trim to 11 1/4"
 (5 5/8" centre
 out)



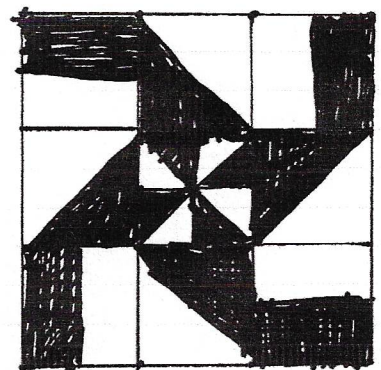
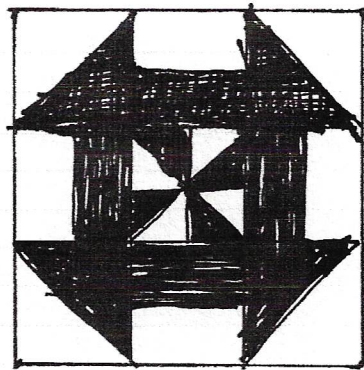
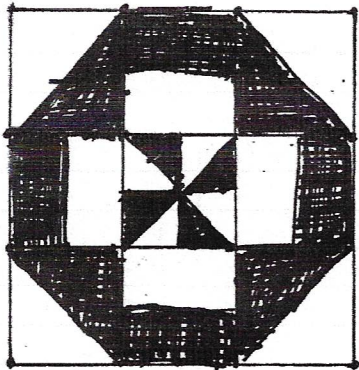
Hourglass
 Trim to 11 1/4"
 (5 5/8" centre out
 Both ways)

cut the 11 1/4" blocks into 3 reds both directions 3 3/4"
 Rearrange each cut □ to form a new pattern.

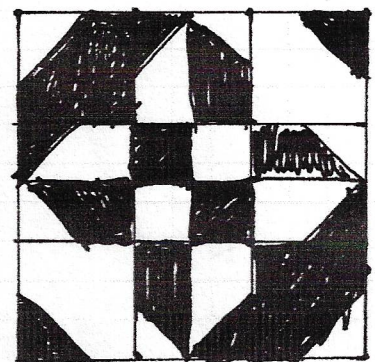
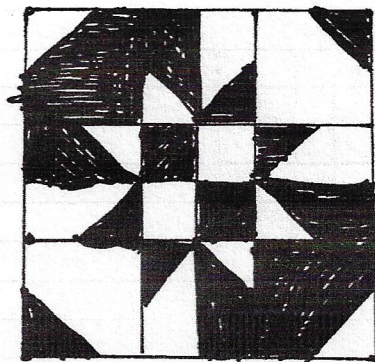
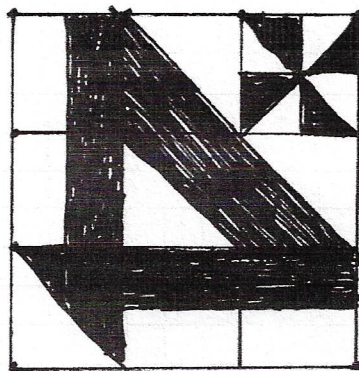

Decide which blocks you want to use to make your Quilt top. and the size you want.

I used $1\frac{1}{2}$ " wide sashing strips between the blocks and as an outside border

Fabric

6 Fat Quarters

Cut

From each fat quarter -

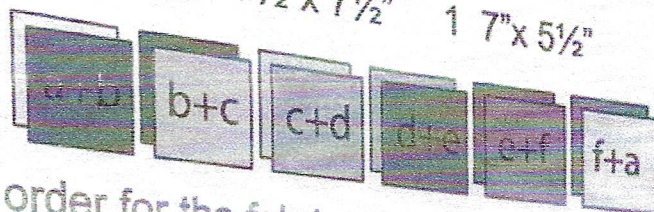
Cut 1 $7" \times 20\frac{1}{2}"$

2 $7\frac{1}{2}" \times 7\frac{1}{2}"$

1 $7" \times 5\frac{1}{2}"$

$38" \times 39"$
Binding... $\frac{1}{2}$ yd

Sew

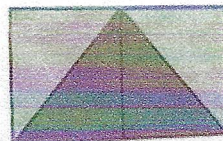
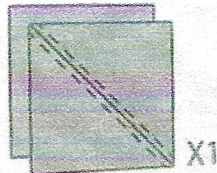


Determine an order for the fabrics and label them a-f.
Pair the squares together according to the diagram.

Mark a diagonal line across the back of one square in each pair and sew $\frac{1}{4}"$ on either side of the line.

Cut apart and press open. Square and trim to $7"$

Assemble the resulting HST's into a flying goose arrangement according to the diagram.



Assemble

Sew the geese together into a vertical row according to the diagram.

Assemble the remaining cut pieces into vertical rows according to the diagram.

Sew the 3 rows together.
